Bailen, Jerome, Salinas, Florence and Kajiwara, Kageaki, eds. Culture of Nationalism in Contemporary Philippine Society: Conference Proceedings. Cordillera Studies Center, 1995.

The papers in this volume result from the conference “Culture of Nationalism in Contemporary Philippine Society” held in Baguio City on March 5-6, 1993. To answer the question on how to mitigate the evil of nationalism in establishing more cultural assertiveness and politico-economic sovereignty, the authors try to situate the various facets of contemporary Philippine nationalism emphasizing its relation to culture.

Salinas, Florence, ed. Sustainable Upland Agriculture: Conference Proceedings. Cordillera Studies Center, 1993.

This report is a compilation of country reports presented during the Conference on Sustainable Upland Agriculture in December 1992. It presents a discussion of general issues such as major forces that destabilize sustainable agricultural production systems in the highlands, the kinds of social and technical interventions effective in reversing such trend, the loss of biodiversity and possible solutions.

This material is the output of the conference “Issues on Cordillera Autonomy” which was aimed primarily to conceptualize the research on Cordillera autonomy. A background on Cordillera autonomy is given and the content of the conference discussed.
